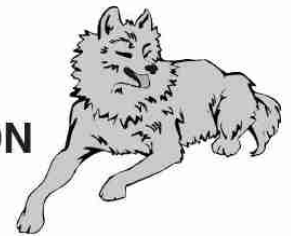

Training Classes

Basic Obedience Class

(for dogs 6 months and older)

We believe a dog is never too old to learn. During class your dog will learn to walk under control on lead, as well as the commands: sit/stay and down/stay for at least three (3) minutes with distractions, and, most important - come when called.

Puppy Class

(8 weeks - 6 months)

Puppy class objectives are similar to basic class, however, attention skills are shorter and all exercises are taught with mild distractions. Puppy class also provides socialization skills. Extra emphasis is placed on house breaking, grooming, nutrition, socialization and proper pet care. This is a critical time in a dog's life where training for proper behavior reduces the development of bad habits.

Equipment

Proper equipment is essential.

Basic Class uses a special 30" flat braided leather leash, a properly fitted chain training collar*, and a 6' leather or nylon slip lead.

Puppy Class uses either a special 6' leather slip lead or a 6' leather leash with a properly fitted chain training collar*.

**for the training collar, you will need to measure your dog's neck and bring the measurement to the first class.*

Private Lessons

Private lessons are not available; however there is additional assistance available for those that may need it during the 30 minute break between classes. Just find one of the trainers during the break, and they will be happy to answer any additional questions, or provide assistance with any problems you may be having.

The First Class

(Do Not Bring Your Dog)

You are invited to attend this 2-hour orientation, demonstration, and registration (you may pre-register by mail) session at **no cost or obligation**. Both Basic and Puppy Class owners meet for this first session. Classes meet separately thereafter at a time to be announced at the first session. These lessons will be approximately 1 hour in length... **Do not bring your dog to this first session.**

A free 5-lb. bag of premium pet food will be given to each class participant.

Cost of Course

\$120 for the 6-week course, payable with registration. Refunds made upon request, for any reason, throughout the end of the first session (orientation) **ONLY!**

All dogs aged 8 weeks or older, purebred or mixed, are welcome to join our next training session. The step-by-step method we use in teaching you to train your dog *does* require you to work with your dog on a daily basis.

We recommend at least 15 - 20 minutes *each* day for the basic class and 5 - 10 minutes *each* day for the puppy class. Each lesson should be followed by a 5 - 10 minute play session.
